

Convention or Non-Convention Applications

Applications must be filed within 12 months of the priority date of the earliest basic application. In order to file a convention or non-convention application, we require the following:

- Specification (in English) comprising:
 - title
 - description (2 copies)
 - claims (2 copies)
 - drawings on letter quality A4 paper (2 copies)
 - abstract (2 copies)
- Full name(s) and address(es) of the applicant(s)
- Full name(s) of the inventor(s)
- Details of the assignment or other transfer of rights in the invention from the inventor(s) to the applicant(s).

If the application claims convention priority we also require:

- Details of the country(ies), application date(s), applicant(s) and application number(s) of the basic application(s); the earliest must be included.
- If the applicant is not the applicant of the basic application(s): details of how the applicant became entitled to claim priority from the basic application.

However, in an emergency, we can secure an effective filing date for a Convention application with only the country, number and date of the basic application, the title of the invention and the broadest claim.
